MINIMALIST TIMBER LIFT AND SLIDE DOOR with double glazing

Skyline Sliding is Carminati’s minimalist manual lift-and-slide system in timber, designed for those seeking the slimmest profile available on the sliding window market—without compromising performance.

With a **visible profile of just 37 mm** and a fixed frame measuring 45 × 184 mm, it optimizes the ratio between glazed surface and structure, significantly increasing natural light intake. The system configuration enhances seamless visual continuity between interior and exterior, reducing the perception of architectural boundaries and elevating transparency as a primary design element.

The extremely slim timber profiles are manufactured in-house with high-precision processes and artisanal finishing, ensuring structural quality, stability, and long-term durability. Thanks to the recessed track sliding system, the horizontal rail and vertical mullion share the same section, guaranteeing a strict and essential visual continuity - expressing a highly refined formal language.

Carminati patented technology

The Skyline sliding system with recessed floor track is the result of a patent developed in 2012. The fiberglass guide, manufactured as a single monolithic block, integrates both the rail and sliding system, ensuring strength and long-term durability. A flexible sealing strip protects the track cavity from dust and debris, maintaining smooth and effortless operation over time. This solution enables the easy movement of even very large sashes, with minimal visual impact. The recessed track creates a flush, level continuity between interior and exterior spaces, enhancing both comfort and architectural quality. Each lift-and-slide system is made to measure: our technical department is available to develop the most suitable solution for the project’s requirements, going beyond standard dimensional limits.

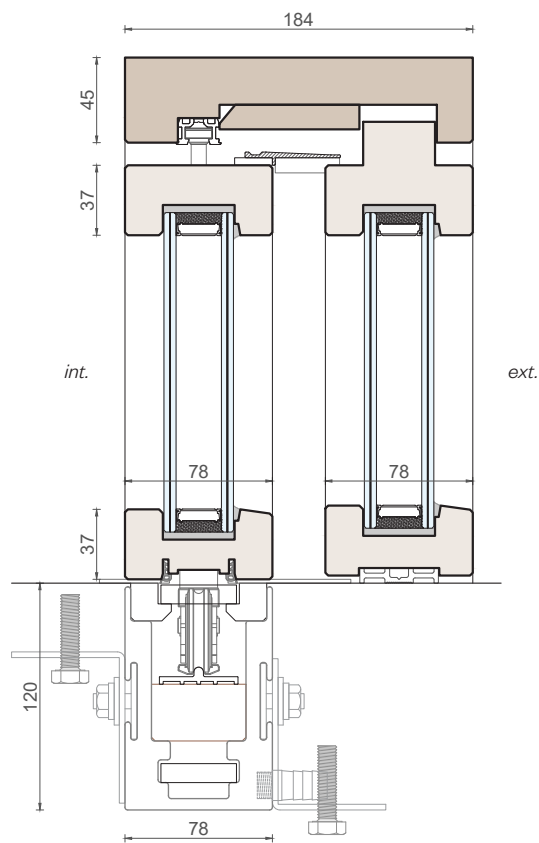
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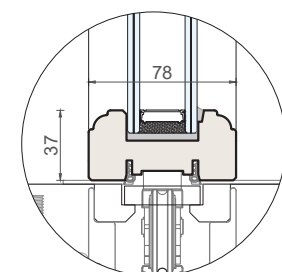
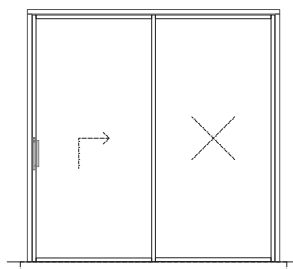
Horizontal section

Elevation view

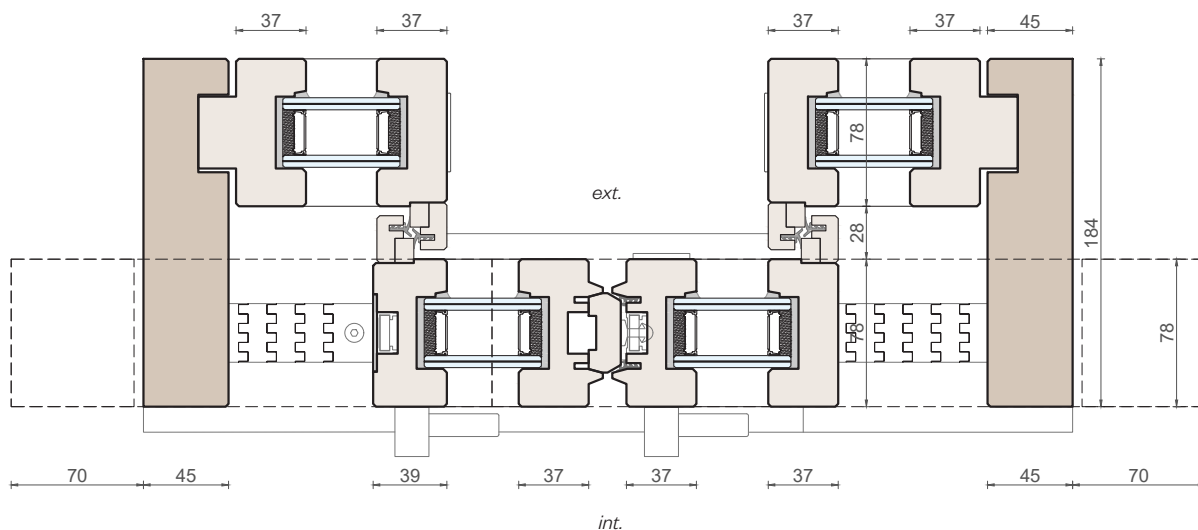

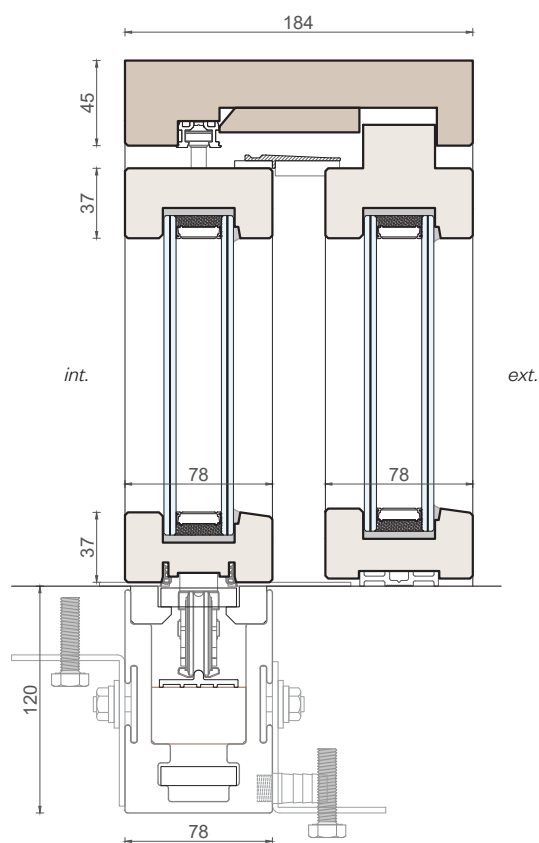
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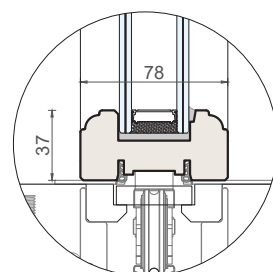
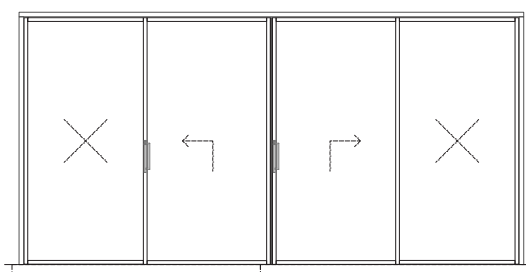
Horizontal section
